This issue reports the decisions taken or ratified by the Board for Graduate Studies and Research at its meeting of February 04, 2021, and thereafter.

PROGRAMMES |

The Board noted:

:: FOR THE CAVE HILL CAMPUS

MSc Nursing

The expansion of the **Master of Science in Nursing** to the Community College in St. Vincent and the Grenadines, with effect from September 01, 2021.

The Board approved:

:: FOR THE CAVE HILL CAMPUS

DipG Paediatric Nursing

– The introduction of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Paediatric Nursing** for commencement either in September 01, 2021 or January 01, 2022.

Master of Business Analytics (with Specialisations)

– The modification of the **Master of Business Analytics** with **new Specialisations** in: (i) **Marketing**; (ii) **Finance**; (iii) **Risk Management and Financial Engineering**; (iv) **Aviation Management**; (v) **Tourism and Hospitality Analytics**; and (vi) **Logistics Analytics**, with effect from September 01, 2021. The specialisations will run every two (2) years on a rotating basis.

:: FOR THE MONA CAMPUS

CerF Neonatology

– The modification of the **Clinical Fellowship in Neonatology**, to extend the duration of the programme from eighteen (18) to twenty-four (24) months, with effect from July 01, 2021.

:: FOR THE OPEN CAMPUS

Continuing & Professional Education Framework

– The revisions to the **Continuing & Professional Education Framework**, with immediate effect.

The Board approved:

An Amendment to Procedure Governing Upgrade of Registration in the Manual of Procedures for Graduate Diplomas and Degrees (2016)

- The new clause 29 (k) reads:

The student is not allowed to communicate with the Assessors or the Assessors with the student to discuss the upgrade assessment. All communication pertaining to the Upgrade Seminar should be facilitated through the Supervisor or the Chair of the Upgrade Assessment Committee.
